Capital Campaign



Non Profit 501(c)(3)

This year we received our 501(c)(3) taxexempt status which allowed us to begin our grant writing and capital fund raising.

Rise Up Industries' goal is to provide a comprehensive set of in-house and outsourced programs and services – funded through donations, philanthropy, and grant monies – in an effort to provide hope, counsel, support, and teach an array of professional and life skills.

Startup Funding

The Challenge

Startup funding can be challenging as foundations and government grants many times want to see the organization's track record. We are working diligently to posture our organization to be an attractive investment for all levels of funding.

We are, therefore, very grateful to all of our donors who have given us their vote of confidence by donating without any evidence of a track record.

Prior to our grant matching campaign, we have received over \$36,000 in private donations including two \$10,000 donations; one from an individual donor and one from Cable Exchange. Thank you - to all of our donors!

Our capital fundraising campaign is ongoing! Therefore, your year-end tax deductible donations would be greatly appreciated.



First Foundation Grant

The Caster Family Foundation provided us with our first foundation grant of \$100,000! The grant is contingent on us receiving matching donations. Thus, we launched our Team Rise Up matching grant campaign. Within seven weeks we were able to raise the required \$100,000 in matching donations, and secured our initial \$200,000!

Reentry Program

Of our three projected programs (prevention, intervention, and reentry) we intend to begin with our reentry program, and plan to open our Reentry Center in the first half of 2015. Our Pilot Reentry Program focuses on gang members who are being released from incarceration and who desire to leave gang life. Our intent is to assist them in successfully meeting their goal.





Phase One

The Reentry Program will require a comprehensive set of services to help our clients in their physical, mental, emotional and spiritual requirements. The program is ambitious, and we will keep our initial enrollment number small as we get our programs in place. The small number will allow us to ensure close integration of the program elements and enable us to develop quality control measures. The quality control measures and procedures will support our future program expansion without loss of quality. Key to our program is to promote an environment of kinship and belonging where each member can recognize their self-worth and enjoy the benefits of real community.

Modeling ourselves after Homeboy Industries, we intend to create several social enterprises which will provide immediate employment opportunities for our members. This service is our vehicle for providing life skills training, work ethic development, and specific job skills. Thus far, we have created two social enterprises, and we're in the planning stages for creating two more.

Coffee Distribution



Rise UP Industries has a social enterprise that offers three boutique coffee's roasted by San Diego Coffee, Tea & Spice Inc. Our coffee is currently available at Major Market in Escondido and Valley Farms Market in Spring Valley.

Our coffees each have a unique story and a distinct taste differential and all are available as freshly roasted beans or ground to perfection; in 12 ounce or 5 pound bags.

Silk Screen & Embroidery



We have taken giant strides in our ability to deliver quality products at a very competitive price. We have exceeded 1,000 tee shirts, and 120 embroidered polo shirts and we are producing our first order of backpacks and ball caps!

Our marketing efforts have been minimal, but the quality and price of our products and the importance of our Mission, have given us a constant flow of referrals. We need everyone's assistance in marketing and referring clients in order to continue to grow this enterprise!

Service

Tattoo Removal



We would like to thank Dr. Kenneth Gross, Kitty Doctor RN, the Skin Surgery Medical Group Inc. and staff for making our tattoo removal program possible. Our collaboration initiative began in August 2013, and in our 16 months of operation we have held twelve sessions, served 48 clients and performed 119 procedures. Our client base continues to grow. We are now serving clients from County Probation, California Department of Rehabilitation, San Diego County of Education Reentry Program, and other non-profits such as Exodus Recovery, the Training Center, and Second Chance. Removing tattoos is a long process and requires genuine commitment on the part of the client, but it plays a significant role in making positive life changes.

Volunteer Opportunities

Mentors

Our intent is to assign a volunteer adult mentor to each of our members (clients). While we currently have no members, we do anticipate launching our Pilot Reentry Program in the first half of 2015. We need to identify and prepare our mentors before the launch, and we envision the mentoring to begin prior to the release from incarceration. Mentoring requires a yearlong commitment.

Special Events

Occasionally we will staff booths at events for the purpose of distributing information about Rise Up Industries and sometimes to sell our coffee. Commitments here can vary from several hours to a full day.
